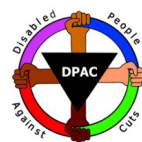
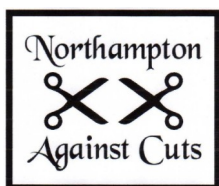

Attacking the Disabled

Changing the Disability Living Allowance will take away £2 billion from disabled people.

Attacking Families

The "spare bedroom tax" takes 14% from the housing benefit of 660,000 families deemed to have one bedroom too many. Council tax benefit is being abolished, and discretionary responsibility passed to local councils already coping with cuts.

Attacking the Young

The immediate threat to housing benefit to the under 25s may have been seen off. However, according to both the Spectator and the Mail on Sunday, Cameron proposes to go into the next election with his attack proposals in place.

The removal of housing benefit from the under 25s will condemn thousands of vulnerable young people to homelessness, and is denounced by homeless charities.

Sowing Division

The Government tries to set employed against unemployed, branding benefit claimants as "shirkers," but most claimants are in work, lacking a living wage.

Forcing Cuts in Local Services

(Although Northamptonshire Tories need no forcing). NCC cuts will affect libraries, preventive services, adult social care, the youth offending service, foster care, trading standards, fire and rescue, early years, meals on wheels, education services and many more. Council employees face unprecedented attacks on pay, conditions and pensions.
